Participate in this day ON WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 20 from 8:00am to 4:30pm

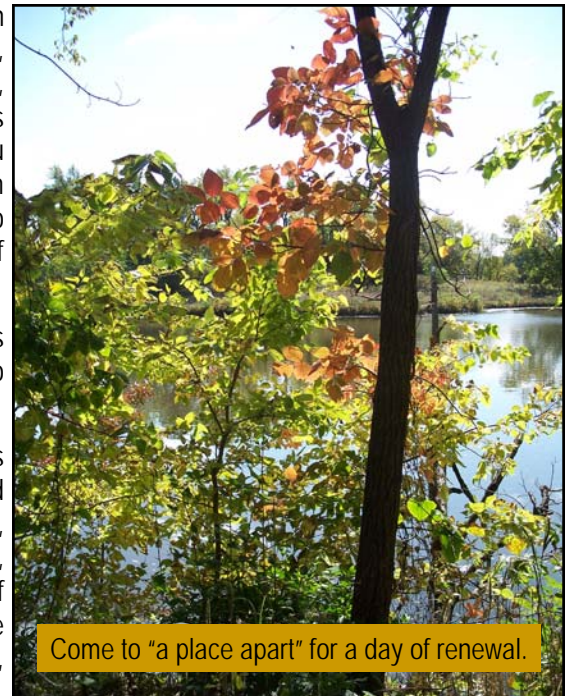
Purpose of Level 2 Program:

4. Simulate an end-of-life scenario using the Compassionate Circle Process™.

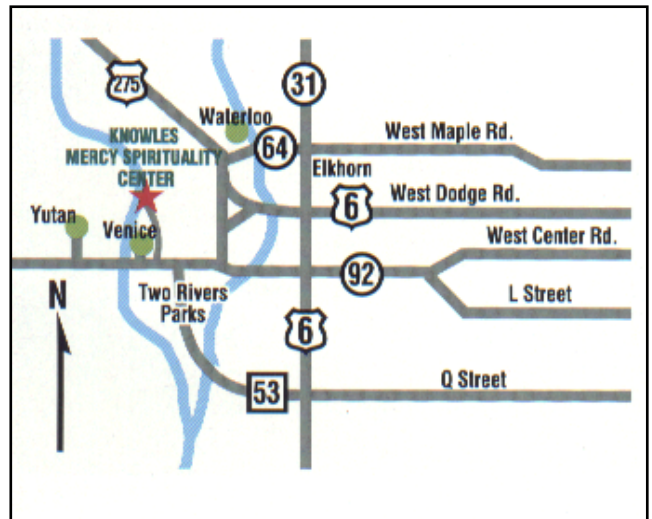
Objectives of Level 2 Program: Being A Supportive Presence
